LEE COUNTY ZONING AND PLANNING COMMITTEES

The Lee County Zoning Board of Appeals and the Regional Planning Commission is providing the following information in conformance with the Freedom of Information Act 55 ILCS 5/5 – 12009 and 65 ILCS 5/5 – 14001.

PURPOSE

The primary functions of the Zoning and Planning Committees are interpretation, administration, and enforcement of the Lee County Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Ordinance. The staff provides information and direction to appointed citizens regarding all development in unincorporated Lee County, from large scale subdivisions to the construction of garden sheds and fences. They provide a formalized process for initiating lawful changes in land use.

The approximate Zoning budget for FY19 is \$77,640. The approximate Planning budget for FY19 is \$5,796.
